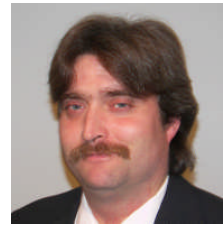

Whatever may be the attitude of our authorities to the Monitorial interpretation they are all agreed that the Symbol is of the greatest importance. Dionysius Lardner, in his edition of "Euclid" writes: "It is by the influence of this proposition and that which establishes to similitude of equilateral triangles (in the sixth book) that geometry has been brought under the dominion of algebra; and it is upon the same principle that the whole science of trigonometry is founded."

Brother J. F. Thompson says that "in it are concealed more ancient symbolism than all other symbols used by, or incident to our order...In it we find concealed the jewels of the Worshipful Master, the Senior and Junior Wardens" and also, he might have added, the Apron, the square, the Tau square and cross.
